Central's on the Wisdom Path: Perspectives, Narratives, and Conversations

Rev. Rebecca "Toddie" Peters Sunday, November 20, 6:00pm In the East Classroom

We welcome Rev. Rebecca "Toddie" Peters, Professor of Religious Studies and Founding Director of the Poverty and Social Justice Program at Elon University for a discussion on her work in reproductive justice and her book, *Trust Women: A Progressive Christian Argument for Reproductive Justice.*

The legal and ethical approach to abortion has become narrowly tailored as an "allowance" provided to women on the basis of "justification" for the need for an abortion. However, a reproductive justice paradigm recognizes the primacy of each and every woman's personal judgment regarding her ability to have children, to not have children, and to sustainably raise and nurture the children she has. In the context of an individual's life, the moral consequences of having a child may be greater than the moral consequences of having an abortion because the moral requirements of motherhood are so enormous.
